Displaced Anger:

Students act out stress onto unsuspecting helpers, sparking explosive and endless power struggles.

Errors in perception:

The Skills

The Theory

The Process

LSCI uses a structured, six-step interviewing process to offer adults and kids in stress a roadmap through conflict. LSCI believes that the process of helping involves having the ability to listen deeply to the personal stories of children and youth and to recognize that their message is often not in their words but in their underlying thoughts and feelings.
